First Grade School Supplies

Books are the property of the school and are on loan to the children for the school year. Parents will be required to pay for any books, including library books, which are lost or defaced. It is the responsibility of the student to keep a book cover on hardbound classroom textbooks that go home with a student. Books are to be carried to and from school in a book bag.

The annual registration fee is used to purchase textbooks, workbooks, testing materials and associated scoring costs, classroom magazines, and additional curricular and instructional items.

All items on the following list are to be furnished by the student's family. Students need to bring the following supplies with them on the first day of school. The teacher will notify the family when supplies are running low and need to be replaced.

Classroom

- A book bag - rolling or regular backpack styles
- 24 pencils with #2 lead. The teachers will keep the pool of pencils for children to use throughout the school year.
- A 12-count package of thin-top washable markers
- A 16-count package of thin-style crayons
- A 12-count package of colored pencils
- An individual dry erase board, markers and eraser – no bigger than 9"x12"
- A pair of safety scissors
- Six (6) washable glue sticks
- Three (3) **plastic** folders with 2 pockets each - any color
- A soft, zippered pencil case. Please do not purchase hard-side pencil cases. They do not fit in the desks.
- Two (2) large boxes of tissues
- Disinfecting wipes

Please do not buy larger packages of markers, crayons, or colored pencils than the teachers have requested. Please buy classic colors.

Art

The classroom teacher and art teacher have requested that children bring a separate bag filled with the following art supplies. Please label the bag with your child's name. The supplies will be stored separately and used only for art class. This new process is designed to better organize supplies and speed up the transition to art class.

- A washable glue stick
- An 8 oz. bottle of washable glue
- A pair of safety scissors
- A few #2 pencils
- A pencil eraser
- A 16-count package of thin-style crayons in classic colors
- A 12-count package of crayola-brand or art-store quality colored pencils in classic colors. The other, less-expensive brands of colored pencils break easily and do not work well in pencil sharpeners.
- Optional: A hand-held pencil sharpener

Note: In any grade where an art portfolio was used, please bring the portfolio back to school with you this year to be used again.
