Kindergarten Curriculum

Religion

Students will

- participate in church weekly.
- take part in morning prayer and prayer before snack.
- know that God loves us.
- identify that God created all things.

Language

Students will

- be able to read over 50 sight words.
- recognize all letters in the alphabet and know their sounds.
- be able to identify beginning and ending sounds.
- know the difference between vowels and consents.
- recognize and create word families.
- show interest in books.
- write words using their sounds.
- use punctuation at the end of a sentence with help.
- print the alphabet A to Z.

Math

Students will

- create and continue patterns.
- be able to count to 100.
- count by 5's and 10's to 100.
- distinguish between odd and even numbers.
- tell time by the hour and half hour.
- participate in calendar work.
- Identify and know the value of a penny, nickel, and dime.
- print number 1-20.

Science

Students will

- identify the different seasons.
- identify which of the five senses they are using.
- be able to name the different parts of a flower.
- describe the basic needs of most plants (water, air, light).
- recognize the life cycle of a plant.
- categorize healthy foods by using the food pyramid.
- label the different parts of a tree and the season.
- categorize the life cycle of a butterfly.

Social Studies

Students will

- explain the importance of friends and family.

- demonstrate how to work together.
- memorize their phone number.
- know their birthday (month, day, year).
- identify maps and the use for them.
- explain and show what do in case of a fire at school and home.

Handwriting

Students will

- demonstrate how to write uppercase and lowercase letters.
- demonstrate how to write numbers.
- use uppercase and lower case letters appropriately.
