

Dear Christ the King family,

Now that we have successfully extracted lent from the grips of St VaLENTine's Day we move on to the spiritual disciplines that we all should respect in order to deepen the quality of our lives from a spiritual dimension. The Scriptures call us to **prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.** These are intended to be the spiritual exercises that enhance the relationships in our lives.

- **Prayer**: our expression of God's presence in our lives giving honor, praise and glory and remaining in communion with God
- **Fasting**: our self-discipline calling us to reduce or eliminate those elements in our life that have a hold on us or are sinful while also incorporating those qualities that have a positive, enriching and grace filed influence upon us personally
- Almsgiving: our awareness of and response to the needs of our less fortunate sisters and brothers the sharing of our resources, our love and respect, and our prayer for them

There you have it – Lent as seen from the perspective of **RELATIONSHIP.** The 2nd century Saint Irenaeus wrote, "*The glory of God is man fully alive.*" That is what Lent offers us: the opportunity to become more fully alive with the grace of God and within the life of Christ. Do not let this moment pass by in vain. I will be praying for you.

Please consider the opportunities that are at your disposal. Elsewhere in this note you will find information concerning the *Mission Mondays* program we will offer in conjunction with St Joseph parish, the **Wednesday evening 6:30 pm Mass** (with opportunity for Confession from 6-6:25pm), the *Hallow* program with additional information and details on the vestibule tables, and the **Stations of the Cross** that are always available for you to pray while the church is open, and the 3pm Stations on Good Friday. You are also welcome to join the school students as they pray Stations on **Friday, 2/23 at 1:00 pm**. (Dates for Stations of the Cross in March with the school to be determined.) Also, consider attending one of the performances of **"The Song of Mark"** – dates and times provided later in this note. The ensemble features soloists, instrumentalists, adult, and children's choirs from area churches including Christ the King.

May the Lord bless us as we navigate our way through this time of grace, hope and maturation in the spiritual life.




